## Enhancements to NSLDS Student Access

### Redesign of Home Page

The home page of NSLDS Student Access has been redesigned to include a clear and complete listing of the functions available to students on the site, with buttons to take the student to each page. The top menu "ribbon" which appears on every page has also been updated to show all functions. When a student selects an option, they are taken to a login page, and then to the selected page. Once logged in, students can navigate to any page in the site. The home page also includes the "MyStudentData Download" button which allows a student to request a complete file of all their aid information.

## Retrieve Your Loan Information

The National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) is the U.S. Department of Education's (ED's) central database for student aid. NSLDS receives data from schools, guaranty agencies, the Direct Loan program, and other Department of ED programs. NSLDS Student Access provides a centralized, integrated view of Title IV loans and grants so that recipients of Title IV Aid can access and inquire about their Title IV loans and/or grant data.

## Enhancements to the Enrollment Page

The Enrollment page has been enhanced with the addition of program-level enrollment history. This allows the student to see the enrollment information that is used by NSLDS to determine the interest subsidy status of subsidized loans that are subject to the Direct Subsidized Loan Limit, for new borrowers on or after July 1, 2013. The student can also view the current campus-level enrollment status. The "Add a School" form on this site allows a student to tell NSLDS that they will be attending a new school, and to provide a date when the student will be attending. NSLDS will add the student to that school's enrollment roster as of that date to request certified enrollment from the new school.

NSLDS uses campus-level enrollment reported by schools to determine when your loans enter repayment and whether you are eligible for an in-school deferment. This page allows you to see which schools we are contacting to confirm your current campus enrollment.

NSLDS uses program enrollment to determine whether you retain the subsidies on any direct loans you already have that are subject to subsidized usage limits and whether you remain eligible for more loans subject to usage limits in the future.

If the school(s) you are attending or plan to attend are not listed under "Current Campus Enrollment", use the "Add a School" form to let NSLDS know that it should contact the school for your enrollment information. Please supply an enrollment confirmation date so we do not contact your school before you enroll. When you are finished, use the Submit button to save changes.

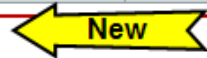
### Your Direct Subsidized Loans: Eligibility and Usage

The TEACH Grant Exit Counseling session provides information about the terms and conditions of a TEACH Grant service agreement, as well as the rights and responsibilities that apply if your TEACH Grant is converted to a Direct Unsubsidized Loan. If you are not ready to begin, or would like to review the TEACH Grant Exit Counseling content, click on the **Tour** button. While in Tour mode, you can review all TEACH Grant Exit Counseling content, but you will not be able to enter any data needed during a true TEACH Grant Exit Counseling session, nor will the Tour session satisfy your TEACH Grant Exit Counseling requirement.
